

PRIVACY POLICY

In this document, PRIVACY POLICY, “You”/“Your” is referred to the User/ Visitor/Client/Company/Agent/Individual or a person who access this website Mor077.com. “We” “Us” and “Our” is referred to Mo77 (CDB).

GENERAL DATA

When you access our website, we may processes data about your use of our website to determine clients, potential clients and other visitors to our website for analytical purposes by a third party company or an entity. The data is processed as we have a legitimate interest in improving our products and services. The monitoring and usage of data will include your IP address, geographical location browser and navigation path, the times and the length of time and the frequency of use by placing of cookies to enhance your website experience. We may process your personal data provided by you during the course of interaction between us (you and us) including data of any inquiry you may or may have submitted, account/login and email details, contact forms & web chat via this site and email. We do not share your personal details with others or third parties except for those who perform, process and supply certain services such as email management, hosting and payment processing services in order for us to perform our contractual obligations to our clients as we have a legitimate interest in management of customer relationships.

DATA PORTABILITY

Your personal details may be transferred to countries outside of the European Economic Area (EEA) as certain products and services are provided by countries outside of European Economic Area (Read below).

Our hosting services are located in the United States of America (USA) outside the European Economic Area (EEA). The USA provides a standard data protection clauses adopted and approved by the EEA.

Data transferred to the USA provides a standard data protection clauses adopted and approved by the EEA. (The EEA had made an “adequacy decision” that the USA can provide the standard protection clauses adopted from the EEA). The EU-US privacy shield which is compliant with EU data protection requirements. You agree and acknowledge that any data you submit through our website may be available on the internet around the world. You accept and acknowledge that the data submitted via our website can potentially be exposed to theft, misappropriation and other data breaches that are beyond our control. We may process communications (content data) received from you for example, content and generated website metadata using the contact forms and other user communications including consultation queries, notifications, web-chat, email and help. We have a legitimate interest in record keeping for client communication, management and administration of our services and products, maintenance of website and content management to improve overall business and for proper business practices.

We may amend and/or update this policy and other website content from time to time. Please check for changes and updates frequently.

HOW WE MAY PROCESS YOUR DATA

We may process your data relating to your website use, referral source, page views, time and length of view, operating system, browser type and version, the source of usage data for analysis and tracking, monitoring and for improving our products and services and to maintain our website services - database, back up, communication and website security.

When you visit our website, cookies are placed by a web server in your browser and then sent back to the server as an identifier (a string of letters and numbers). Our server may place two types of cookies in your browser. A session and a persistent cookies. A session cookie stored by the browser expires at the end of the user session and when the browser closes. A persistent cookie stored by the browser will remain valid until its expiry date unless it is deleted by the user at anytime before its expiry date.

Cookies do not contain personally identifiable information. They help to determine the user's preference and for customisation for a better web browsing experience. It also helps to protect the user accounts to prevent fraudulent logins helping the user with a better security. It also allows us to display user relevant advertisements and for analysis of our web performance and services.

We are committed to safeguarding your personal and sensitive data, unless we have a legal obligation and that it is necessary to disclose your personal and other sensitive data for compliance for safety & security of you and others and/or for any other reasons that we might be legally obliged to do so, such as to determine, establish a defence claim in court or out-of-court procedure under which circumstances would be our legitimate interest and the legal basis in doing so.
